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LANGEBAAN YOUTH LIFE AWARENESS PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION

1. Langebaan is an idyllic coastal town with enormous possibilities. Development has indeed reached us, and much more is being planned. - e. Nature camps.
- f. Organized sport activities.
- g. Organized sport training sessions.
- h. Drug counseling.
- i. Historical Trips eg. Robben Island

OUTCOMES BASED LIFE SKILLS

6. All skills as mentioned above, in the proposed program, are there with the aim to constructively engage the youth as well as to influence the youth in a positive and responsible manner. Life skills are not taught bmo a prescribed handbook – hence this approach. Teamwork, dedication and experience will form the core aspects. Responsible adult leadership is of critical importance.

7. Playful teachings are also being encouraged such as:

- a. Seek and find.
- b. Make a plan with limited resources.
